In year 2000, GEA College – Faculty of Entrepreneurship founded International Office. International Office is responsible for all international activities. During past 13 years we have developed good international partnerships within Europe and also worldwide, especially in countries from ex- Yugoslavia, North America and China. We cooperate in different projects within mobility of students, teaching and non-teaching staff. As well we cooperate in the frame of joint researches with our European and non-European partners. Our Faculty is specialized in Entrepreneurship so we choose our partners from business education area. We provide high quality, practically oriented education on 2 levels (1st and 2nd Cycle), focused on gaining a lot of practical experience during study. The strategy is international focus, to establish new partnerships and to develop networks with current educational Institutions. We also organize Advances in Business-Related Scientific Research Conference. ABSRC is an important international gathering of business and business-related sciences scholars and educators.
